Applications for transfer to <u>high school</u> must be submitted by 20th November 2023.

Applications for admission to <u>reception</u> class in September 2024 <u>close on 7th January 2024</u>.

Only applications received by the published closing date for receipt of preference forms will be considered in the initial round of allocation of places. Other preference forms received will be considered as late applications. Please contact the school if you need support in completing the forms.

Also, please pass this information on to anybody you know that does not currently have a child in school to ensure they do not miss the dates. Thank you.

Speaking to Teachers

We understand that it may be difficult to speak with teachers. If you have any queries or concerns about your child, please do not hesitate to telephone us at school, Dojo or write a short note – we will be happy to arrange an appointment for you to speak to either myself or to the class teacher. Please remember teachers cannot answer messages in the school day whilst they are teaching or late in the evening.
