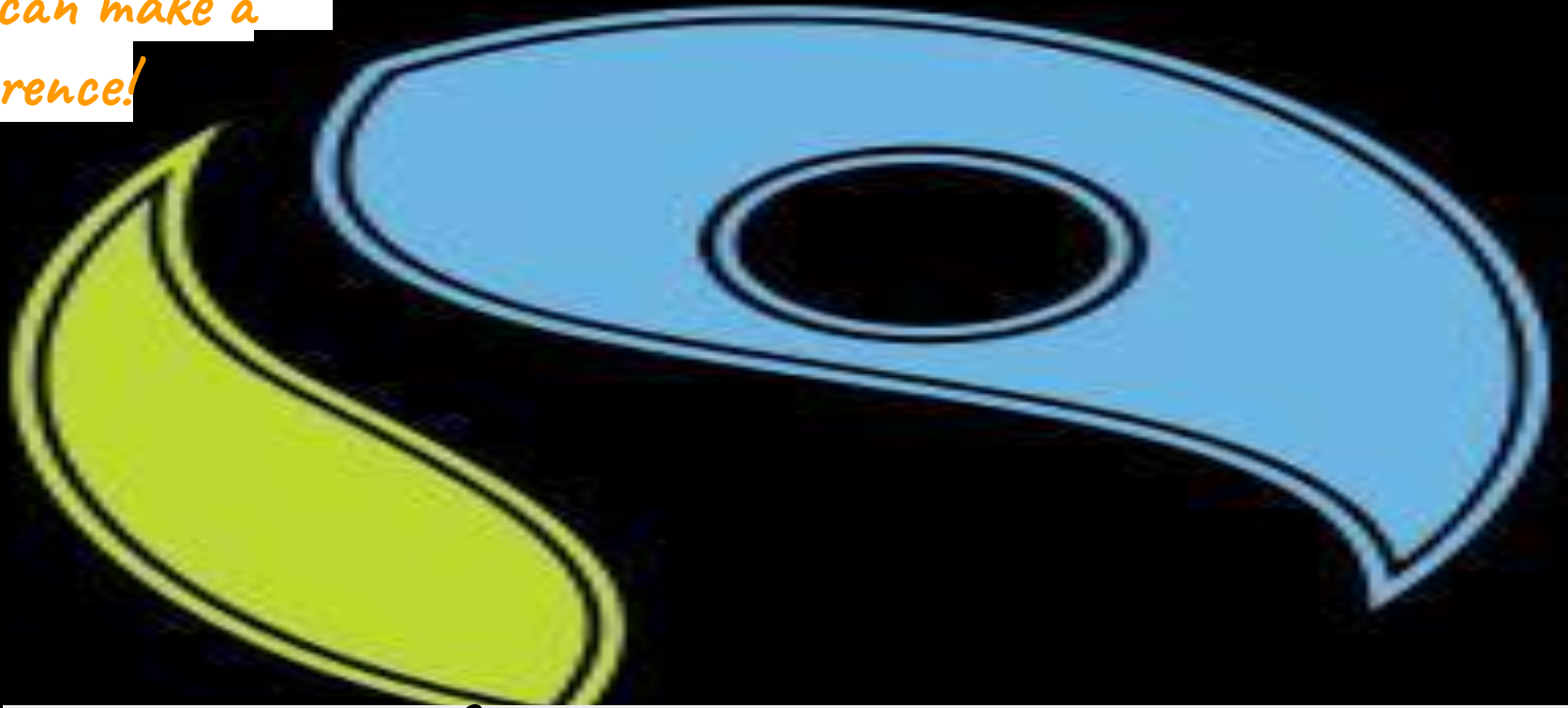

Fairtrade

What is Fairtrade?

Fairtrade is a way of buying and selling products that allows the farmers to be paid a fair price for their produce, and have better working conditions. Right now farmers all over the globe are being paid only 75 euro cents a day for picking bananas and less for many more jobs.

You can buy Fairtrade products such as coffee, chocolate, bananas, biscuits and sugar. Look for a logo which looks like this on your food.
