

Dear Parent / Carer,

The next project that we have given the children is based on our current context, Burps, Bottoms and Bile. All pupils should choose an aspect of this topic in which they would like to become an expert. They need to research this aspect in detail and present their findings in an interesting and attractive way.

Some ideas for research topics (although they may choose something different if they would like):

- The digestive system as a whole
- How scientists research the body
- How diet affects the body / Healthy eating
- Why and how do we burp?
- Parts of the digestive system
- History of the toilet / hygiene

They are limited to using a double page only in their books, although they may be creative in ways to extend their space e.g. fold out pages, envelopes, pop outs etc. They may wish to make a 3D model to accompany their written work.

Learning Logs can be kept at home while the research is being completed, but must be returned to school by **Thursday 29th January** with a completed piece of work. This time pupils will individually present their Learning Logs to the class. They can talk about their research and what they have found out. They will be given time to practise their presentation in school, they may also find it helpful to practise their presentation at home. If your child needs any help or advice, please don't hesitate to ask.

We would appreciate it if you could support your child with this challenge and we can't wait to see the results!
